



KIM FERRER | Artist Statement

Change is nature's lesson in impermanence.

The transition of fall into winter, winter into spring, spring into summer and summer into fall reveals a gradual process of acceptance, shedding, surrender and renewal. These recurring cycles of the seasons become a reminder as well as a metaphor of our own experiences of loss, change and new beginnings.

Simple raw materials are revisited to portray passage through a season of change. Natural and crafted lines depict patterns on wood, porcelain and paper suggesting rhythms reflected in nature while becoming metaphors of shedding a past or unfolding into a future.

This small body of work mirrors a life moving within the transitory state of nature that is forever shifting, rearranging and letting go into new configurations of being in the world.
